

COVID-19 Health & Safety Accommodations

2020-2021 School Year

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, Prince of Peace Lutheran Preschool has implemented the changes listed below for the 2020-2021 school year. Please keep in mind that the situation with the pandemic is highly fluid and will change significantly between now and the end of the school year. Thus, our planning process will be ongoing as well to quickly respond to changing conditions. We will continue to do our best to always prioritize the safety and well-being of our students in an environment conducive to their education and growth and development.

Arrival

- Please drop your child off at the classroom door.
- Their temperature will be taken at the front door and they will wash their hands.
- Parents or caregivers, please wear a mask when interacting with staff.
- Backpacks/bags are required and all personal items, including rest time blankets, will be stored therein.

Hand Washing

- Required upon arrival
- After the restroom
- Before snack and after snack
- Before and after playground time, hand sanitize in between
- Any other time that the teacher feels it is necessary, such as coughing or sneezing

Masks

- Teachers and staff will wear masks
- Students are not required to wear a mask unless it is requested by a parent

School Cleaning and Sanitizing

- Teachers will continue to clean high touch surfaces in the classroom
- Our Maintenance staff will focus on cleaning and sanitizing common areas like the gate and keypad, exterior doors/handles, playground, bathrooms, and classroom floors. He/she will help us ensure that cleaning and disinfecting procedures in the classrooms meet the needs for battling the coronavirus.
- Teachers will rotate toys and educational materials that will be sanitized and cleaned by hand.

Classroom

- Maintain a small group size of 9 students or less
- Mid-morning temperature checks will be taken
- Social distance center activities and free play will be encouraged
- Children will leave a change of clothes in the classroom in a Ziploc bag

Meal Time

- Social distancing will be implemented at meal time
- All meals will continue to be served in individual portions

Lunch Bunch (VPK)

- Students will have their own individual mat for rest time, which will be sanitized each day after use.
- Students will socially distance during rest time, with a separation of 6 feet.

Tuition and Classroom Closure

- There will be no tuition refunds if a classroom is temporarily closed due to COVID exposure. The teachers will provide activities and resources for the students to experience educational enrichment at home.
