

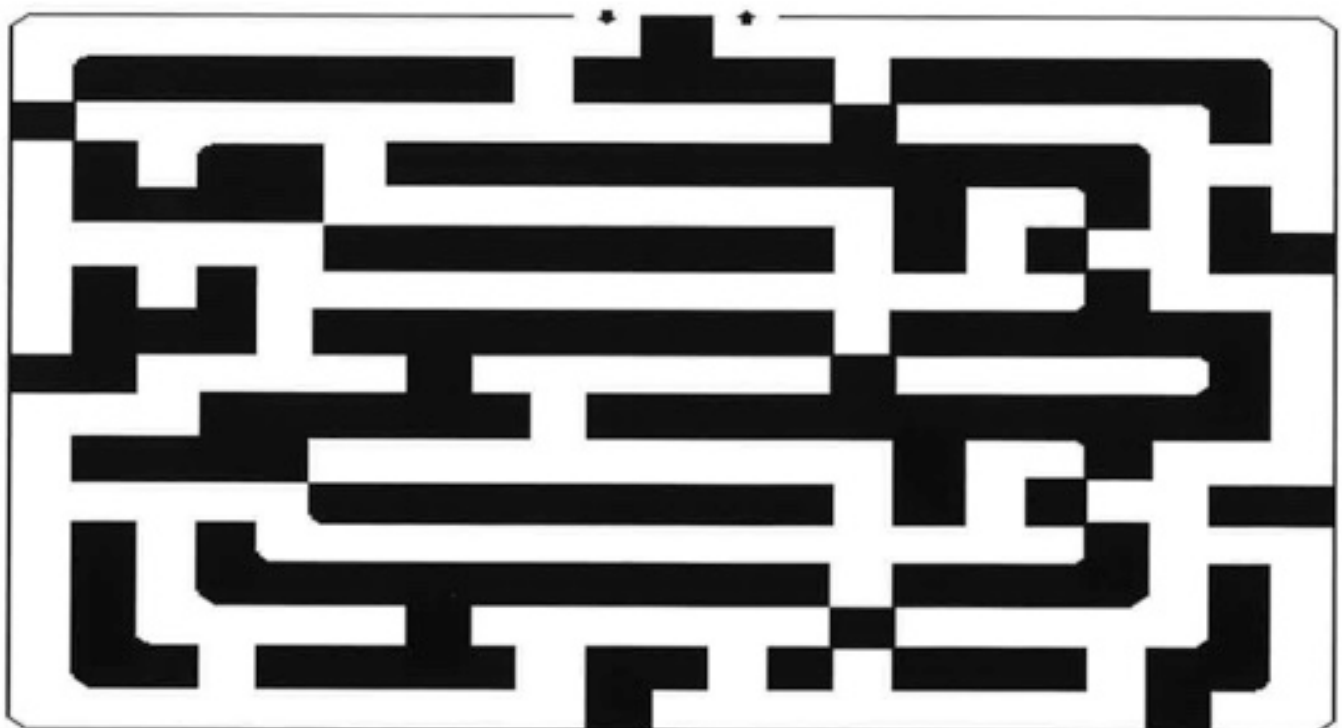

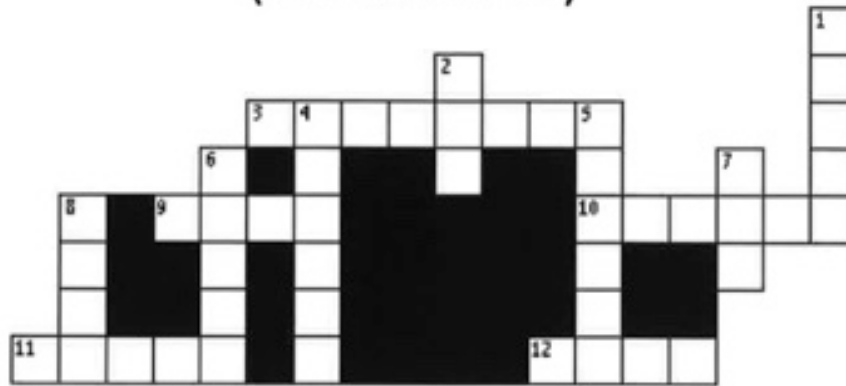

## 62. THE CALLING OF GIDEON (JUDGES 6:11-40)



- 5 DOWN "Now the Angel of the LORD came and sat under the terebinth tree which was in Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, while his son \_\_\_\_\_ threshed wheat in the winepress, in order to hide it from the Midianites." **JUDGES 6:11**
  
- 6 DOWN "And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him, and said to him, 'The LORD is with you, you mighty man of \_\_\_\_\_!'" **JUDGES 6:12**
  
- 9 ACROSS "Then the LORD turned to him and said, 'Go in this might of yours, and you shall \_\_\_\_\_ Israel from the hand of the Midianites. Have I not sent you?'" **JUDGES 6:14**
  
- 1 DOWN "So he said to Him, 'O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan is the strongest in Manasseh, and I am the \_\_\_\_\_ in my father's house.'" **JUDGES 6:15**
  
- 10 ACROSS "And the LORD said to him, 'Surely I will be with you, and you shall \_\_\_\_\_ the Midianites as one man.'" **JUDGES 6:16**
  
- 11 ACROSS "Now it came to pass the same night that the LORD said to him, 'Take your father's young bull, the second bull of seven years old, and tear down the \_\_\_\_\_ of Baal that your father has, and cut down the wooden image that is beside it.'" **JUDGES 6:25**
  
- 3 ACROSS The LORD also said, "Build an altar to the LORD your God on top of this rock in the proper arrangement, and take the second bull and offer a burnt \_\_\_\_\_ with the wood of the image which you shall cut down." **JUDGES 6:26**
  
- 4 DOWN "Gideon said to God, 'If You will save Israel by my hand as You have said-- look, I shall put a \_\_\_\_\_ of wool on the threshing floor.'" **JUDGES 6:36-37**
  
- 12 ACROSS "If there is dew on the fleece only, and it is dry on the ground, then I shall \_\_\_\_\_ that You will save Israel by my hand, as You have said.'" **JUDGES 6:37**
  
- 8 DOWN "And it was so. When he rose early the next morning and squeezed the fleece together, he wrung the dew out of the fleece, a bowl \_\_\_\_\_ of water." **JUDGES 6:38**
  
- 2 DOWN "Then Gideon said to God, 'Do not be angry with me, and let me speak just once more: Let me test, I pray, just once more with the fleece; let it now be \_\_\_\_\_ only on the fleece, but on the ground let there be dew.'" **JUDGES 6:39**
  
- 7 DOWN "It was dry on the fleece only, but there was \_\_\_\_\_ on all the ground." **JUDGES 6:40**
