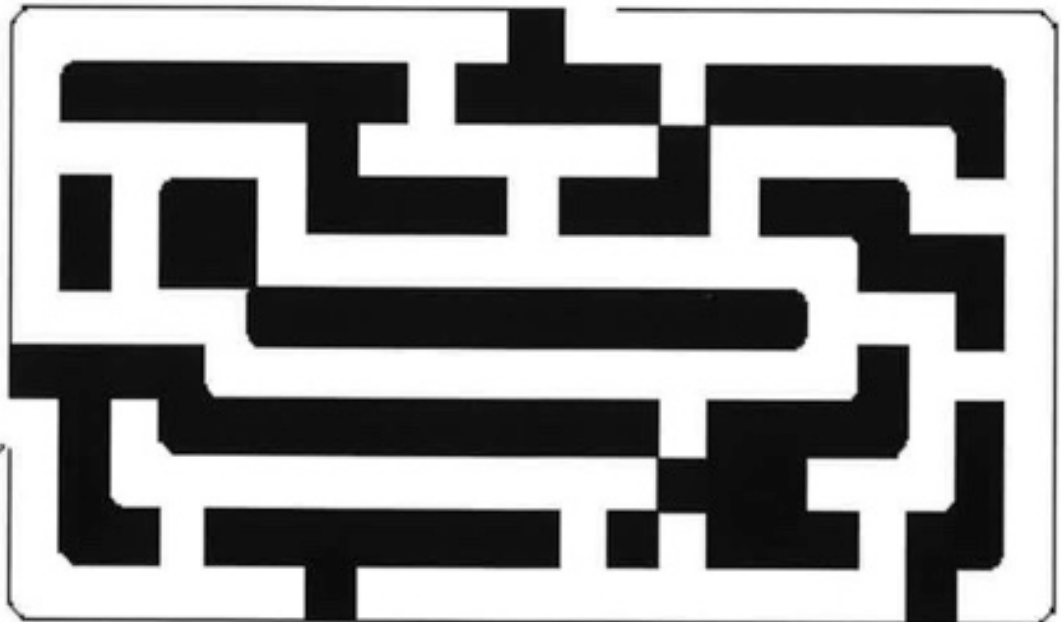

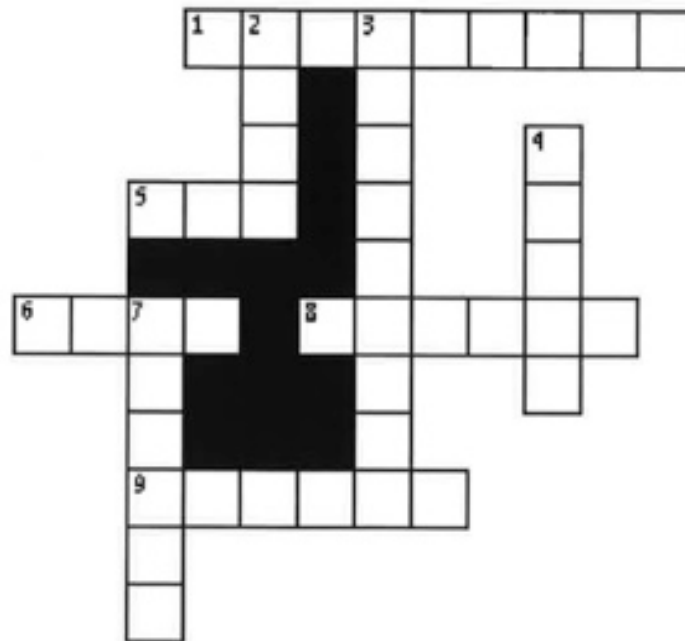

## (LUKE 1:5-25)



- 3 DOWN "There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judea, a certain priest named \_\_\_\_\_, of the division of Abijah. His wife was of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elizabeth." **LUKE 1:5**
- 1 ACROSS "But they had no child, because \_\_\_\_\_ was barren, and they were both well advanced in years." **LUKE 1:7**
- 9 ACROSS "So it was, that while he was serving as \_\_\_\_\_ before God in the order of his division, according to the custom of the priesthood, his lot fell to burn incense when he went into the temple." **LUKE 1:8-9**
